



TERMS AND CONDITIONS THAT APPLY TO APPLICATIONS TO THE FLETCHER BUILDING EMPLOYEE EDUCATIONAL FUND (EEF) RELATIVE TO STUDIES TOWARDS POST HIGH SCHOOL QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicants must have a parent or guardian who has completed at least six months' continuous service with Fletcher Building (or a Fletcher Building subsidiary company) to be eligible to apply for a tertiary scholarship.
- Applications must be received by the EEF by close of business on the application closing date in December each year as referenced on the web site.
- Late applications will not be considered by the Trustees.
- All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application, via e-mail, regardless of whether they are fortunate to be awarded a grant or not.
- Successful applicants will be required to:
 - produce evidence of confirmed enrolment in a full time course of study for the entire ensuring academic year
 - sign an agreement in which they will commit to attend lectures, complete assignments by due date, sit required examinations and generally do all that is required of them as a full-time student at a tertiary institution, for the entire academic year.
- Students continuing studies towards a post-high school qualification will need to provide an official copy of satisfactory results for all studies completed to date towards their post-high school qualification (attach to on-line application all results available at the time of applying)
- Scholarships are awarded at the absolute discretion of the EEF and are not subject to any rights of review or appeal.
